Parts Cleaning Instructions.

What product do I use?

- For ALL seawater applications, Zebra Mussel Buster is the only choice for safe, fast, and consistent results.
- Also available in a concentrated form, one gallon of Zebra Mussel Buster Concentrate makes five gallons of Zebra Mussel Buster.

Cleaning

The best and most effective way to use Zebra Mussel Buster for cleaning is when the vessel's hull is dry.

- Spray Zebra Mussel Buster on the surface to be cleaned i.e.: propellers, shafts, anchors, dinghies, or any other component in contact with seawater.
- Let stand for at least 15 minutes without letting the solution dry. If necessary, reapply more solution.
- Rinse well with fresh water or a pressure washer.
- Repeat until all residues are removed.

TRAC Tip:

It is recommended to test in an inconspicuous area before use. Zebra Mussel Buster is noncorrosive and is safe on paint, fiberglass, vinyl, wood, plastics, rubbers, porcelain and most metals, if used as directed.



Parts Cleaning

When circulation is not possible, Zebra Mussel Buster can be used by immersion to clean parts such as, freshwater chest, valves, strainers, pipes, etc.

- Soak parts in Zebra Mussel Buster.
- Create agitation by either adding an air hose to the tank or with a plastic centrifugal pump.
- Let the product work for 4 to 8 hours (depending of the amount of residue).
- Wash off with fresh water or a pressure washer.
- Repeat if necessary.

The solution can also be sprayed or brushed on, but several applications may be necessary.
